“COVID -19 COPING WITH ONLINE LEARNING – HEALTH AND PSYCHOLOGICAL ISSUES”

14/07/2020

The covid 19 pandemic has changed the way we teach and learn. On 14th July 2020 a one day webinar on “COVID -19 COPING WITH ONLINE LEARNING – HEALTH AND PSYCHOLOGICAL ISSUES” was organized by Department of Fashion in association with IQAC, Holy Cross from 2pm to 3:30pm. The session was open to the public. Over 200 Teachers, students and parents from different universities joined the webinar. The webinar began with a welcome address by Ms. Sreelakshmi, Head of the Department, Fashion Designing. The Resource person for the webinar was Dr Roshan Bijli K N, Director, Composite Regional Centre for Skill Development Rehabilitation & Empowerment of Person with Disability – Kozhikode (CRC-K). In his presentation he flagged certain important points which students should focus on to avoid anxiety disorder and depression. He spoke about the importance of self-discipline during these uncertain times. Students were given useful tips to cope with anxiety and depression. Dr Roshan provided a daily routine template to follow and stated that the key to managing mental health during the pandemic is to develop new routines and to create a sense of stability. He also mentioned that learning new skills and adopting new hobbies can help with. Audiences were encouraged to limit their time on social media to get a better grip on society. After the presentation Q & A session was conducted where participants raised their questions and sought clarification on issues related to psychological issues.
